- Entrants must be enrolled at an Australian University with proof of enrolment (copy of student ID attached to your entry)
- **Registration of Interest** form must be submitted by Thursday 9 April 2015
- All entrants must be students of Finance, Economics, Commerce, Business, Law or those working in or intending to work in the banking and finance industry
- Entry to this competition is free, however entrants must be a Signatory of The BFO (thebfo.org)
- Films must be **no longer** than 3 minutes in length, if you can 'share your vision' in less then please do so! (This includes credits)
- Entries can be submitted on USB, preferably in high resolution, ideally an MP4 or .mov under 300mb, however we will accept files not in this format
- Each entry is responsible for their transit insurance, postage and production costs. Please do not post USBs in regular envelopes as they are at risk of being ripped during the mailing process

- Confirmation of receipt of entry will be sent via email
- Film entries must address the three criteria:
 1. Be **under** 3 minutes (including credits)
 2. Bring **The Banking and Finance Oath** to life (thebfo.org)
 3. Visually include a **red flag**
- The entry form must be correctly completed, accompany your video entry and be received by the closing date 30 June 2015
- Each entry must contain the entrant's own work and ideas, with appropriate permissions for use. Assistance is permitted, although conceptual ideas must be the entrants
- Entrants can be individuals or groups, however contributors must credited and signatories of The BFO
- A short-list of 10 finalists will be announced on 31 July 2015
- The BFO Board will judge the entrants and the winner announced at an industry event
- Please note that entries will not be returned
- The BFO reserves the right to exclude any entry considered inappropriate. This includes any content that the in The BFO's opinion contains racist, sexist, violent or discriminatory material
- Entries will become the property of The BFO and may be used for promotion or loaded on relevant websites and used in television programs and the creators will be credited for their work.
